Requirements:

- Attend 8 of 10 monthly meetings (no meetings in December or July).
- Complete onboarding orientation.
- Host small community fundraisers in the Hudson Valley to support GOTR scholarships.
- Attend at least two service opportunities per year (e.g., GOTR 5K, Signature Luncheon, or community events).
- Contribute an annual minimum give/get of \$250 (donations, sponsorships, fundraising efforts, or individual donation).
- Serve a one-year term with the possibility of up to two additional terms if all requirements are met.
