DEAR FRIENDS,



The 2024 Summer Olympics in Paris were bursting with "girl power" with 65% of Team USA's gold medals won by females – including New Jersey's own track and field powerhouse and friend of GOTR, Sydney McLaughlin-Levrone! We loved cheering on these athletes who are also role models of strength and resilience for our GOTR girls.

Meanwhile, **Girls on the Run NJ East** set our own record in 2024 by surpassing 25,000 girls served through our programs! We are so proud of each of these thousands of girls in Girls on the Run and Heart & Sole who confidently completed the 5K distance and learned life skills that will serve them well beyond the finish line. Those are gold medal achievements!

This year, we introduced a new research-based curriculum intentionally designed by Girls on the Run International to meet the needs of today's girls. Entitled "Hello, Superstar!," the innovative curriculum helps girls build the confidence to be themselves through meaningful and engaging lessons and the activities that keep them moving.



Other podium-worthy moments in 2024 for Girls on the Run NJ East included:

- **New teams** in Annandale, Belleville, Chesterfield, Hamilton, Mountainside, Newark, Parsippany, Plainfield, South Orange, Trenton, and Willingboro
- More than 58% of volunteer coaches returned for another season
- **49% increase in financial assistance** to expand access for all girls
- 98% of caregivers said our program was a valuable experience for their child


